#### Dear Chairman Symonanis:

On behalf of the Federal Maritime Commission (Commission), this letter responds to the below recommendation of the National Shipper Advisory Committee (NSAC) submitted to the Commission on June 5, 2023.

#### NSAC Recommendation:

**Recommendation:** Require Ocean Carriers and their subcontracted parties, i.e., MTOs, rail carriers, chassis providers, container depots, etc. to publish consistent, aligned, and timely data on the following data elements:

## **Export Cargo:**

- Empty pickup container yard location
- Empty pickup date
- Documentation Cutoff
- Physical Cutoff
- Loaded container location and earliest return date
- Loaded container ingate return

#### **Import Cargo:**

- Container pickup available date
- Container last free port demurrage date
- Container last free equipment detention date
- Empty container return yard location options

# **Commission Response**:

Commissioner Carl W. Bentzel led a Maritime Transportation Data Initiative (MTDI). Commissioner Bentzel held meetings open to the public with maritime and intermodal stakeholders starting in December 2021 and continuing through to a Data Summit in June 2022. Commissioner Bentzel completed his final report in April 2023. At the Commission's May 3, 2023, meeting, Commissioner Bentzel summarized his work on the MTDI and the recommendation he identified for next steps. Insofar as this is still an ongoing process, the Commission thanks the NSAC for its recommendations. It will take them into consideration as it determines next steps for the MTDI.
